



HSRDC GRANT APPLICATION

EXPLANATION AND GUIDELINES FOR RECEIVING A GRANT.

The HSRDC (Houston Square and Round Dance Council) is making funds available to Houston area clubs that are in need. The overall intention is for clubs to use the grant monies to grow their club. Some may consider using funds for paying for their hall, class caller or moving to a new facility.

First and foremost, filling out an application does not guarantee receipt of monies. **All application decisions is the sole discretion and final as decided by the HSRDC board.**

- Only one grant may be submitted per club per calendar year.
- Awarded funds shall not exceed \$500 per accepted application.
- If a club's application is refused, they may submit another grant that presents a different purpose than the first grant in that same calendar year.
- HSRDC may need to contact clubs for clarification before final decisions are made.
- *ALL GRANT APPLICATIONS submitted will have up to a 30-day waiting period before the application is either awarded or denied. This allows time for deliberation; please plan accordingly.*
