



HSRDC OFFICES IN REVIEW

The offices of Friendship Director, Historian, Photographers and Class Coordinator and Educational Director follow the same guidelines as other appointed officers. They are expected to attend HSRDC functions and wear their HSRDC badge and proper square dance attire. Special assignments to the Friendship Director position are to maintain the records of all dancers that submit Friendship visitation cards, distribute the badges earned and submit a report to the Where N When editor in a timely fashion. Oscar and Suzi Aleman are the 2013 Friendship Directors.

The 2013 Historians are Dan and Marlene Payne. Dan is an expert in cataloging photos and keeping great records of past and present pictures. In fact, Dan has designed his own program to fit his needs! He will also compile this year's scrapbooks.

Dan is also a photographer along with Kaye and Bill Lewis and Raymond Fisher. As designed by their title, they take pictures of all events during the year. All photographers will turn their pictures into Dan to review for the scrapbooks. If any square dancer wants to submit pictures for Dan to review you may.

The positions of Class Coordinator and Education Director have been combined. Wayne and Donna Meiers have filled this position for many years. The duties of this office are to maintain a list of clubs that are conducting lessons, have this information available to the president and for publication in the Where N When, be a contact for any person requesting lessons, confirms with clubs the actual graduation date, be the custodian of all educational materials and see that these are prepared for each graduation and available upon request by any club. Upon request they will provide a display of educational materials at Quarterly meetings, New Dancer Jamboree and Trade N Buy and student dances. They will attend as many graduations as possible to present materials to new students and upon request be part of the graduation ceremony.

~~~~Don't forget the Trade N Buy/New Dancer Jamboree on April 13 in Friendswood. This is a great opportunity for all dancers to add to their dance attire for a reasonable cost or to sell square dance attire that is no longer needed. Don't forget to bring cash in small bills. Change is often an issue. A donation of \$3 is requested of ALL dancers to offset any expenses. If you need some tips on how to choose square dance clothes look for an article written by Jimette Smith in this issue giving you some advice.

\*\*\*Club officers that are in charge of admissions may want to review the policy that refers to which elected and/or appointed offices can receive free admission into a dance. Just as a reminder.....any officer that is attending on HSRDC business or caller/cuer is not expected to pay a donation at the door. It is a policy that the Presidents do not pay on any visitation; however, they are not the only officers that donate much time and energies to promoting our activity. Many clubs have elected to admit the executive officers without a donation to all dances, especially Anniversary Dances. Again, this may be a way to show your appreciation to these officers that donated much time and energies to promote this activity.

## FEATURED CLUBS OF THE MONTH

## **Crosby Swinging Squares**

In May of 1984, a group of club members were gathered at the Newport Country Club and the conversation drifted to social activities. Someone mentioned an interest in learning to square dance, an activity enjoyed all over the world. This idea brought great interest and it was decided that they would attempt to get a club started. John Bymes contacted Jim Pyle and ask him to cue for the club. Jim Pyle enthusiastically took action and called Merrbach Record Service who produced square dancing records in Houston. Through Merrbach Records Hubert Kerr was contacted. Hubert agreed to teach lessons and to call dances for the club. The Newport Country Club manager, Jake Bodiford, was approached for a free room at the club to begin square dancing. Jake agreed and offered adequate space for the square dancers as well as publicity in the Newport Country Club calendar.

In August of 1984, the first meeting was held and election of officers as well as basic rules for the club. The club voted to dance on Thursday nights at the Newport Country Club and to name the club Newport Swinging Squares. At that time the club joined the Houston Square and Round Dance Council. The first Thursday in September 1984 Hubert Kerr instructed the beginner and mainstream classes. Unfortunately they had to dance on a carpet floor; that was not comfortable for dancing.

In 1989, the opportunity came for the club to move to the Knights of Columbus Hall in Crosby. There was ample space and a better floor for dancing. However, the Knights of Columbus Hall's location was often difficult for visiting clubs to locate.

In 1997, for a better location, the club moved into the center of Crosby to the American Legion Hall on FM 2100 where they have a nice wooden dance floor. In 1999, the club voted to rename the club to Crosby Swinging Squares so that other clubs would recognize that the club danced in Crosby, Texas.

## FEATURED CLUBS OF THE MONTH

## History of The Woodlands Stars

In the spring of 1978 a small group of would-be square dancers gathered at the Woodlands Swim and Athletic Center and under the instruction of Luther Pitchford began what is today, The Woodlands Stars Dance Club. Luther directed the group slowly through the fall and winter months.

Among the original group were Snowden and Alma Nantz who danced earlier with the Springalings, Don and Ginger Neville who had learned to square dance in Singapore, and Tony and Laura Catania.

In February 1979, Jerry and Mary Markowich made their first visit to The Stars. They had learned to square dance in Pleasantville, New York. In March 1979 the group hired a new caller, a young man named Kevin Bacon, and moved their location to Jan Pierce Dance Studio in Oak Ridge. Dancing with at least one square the club took shape as a group of friends having fun square dancing (and that's still what square dancing is all about - having fun!). The officers were Fred and Cass Shetz, President.; Don and Ginger Neville, Vice President; Lynn and Becky Affleck, Treasurer; and Jerry and Mary Markowich, Secretary.

Ten couples signed the by-laws and became the charter members



## **HEARING ASSIST UNITS**

A number of clubs, callers and cuers are using hearing-assist systems. These systems consist of a transmitter that's hooked up to the sound system and receivers with ear-bud or ear-speaker worn by dancers. Dancers can purchase the receiver for around \$100.00 to \$160.00 depending on the model. The caller/cuer typically transmits voice signal (this is what most dancers who are hearing-impaired have trouble picking up).

An assistive listening system makes a wireless, electronic connection between the sound source and your ear. This "bridging" effect eliminates the effects of distance, background noise and reverberation so that you can hear and understand better; it's like having the sound source right next to you. If you are in the back of the room, the sound volume can be adjusted at your ear to be as loud as you want, without increasing the loudness of the background noise in the room. Even if the room is noisy or very reverberant, you should still be able to hear clearly, since the listening system is bypassing all the acoustical conditions in the room.


