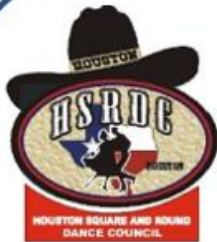
Our 2nd Quarter Council Meeting will be held prior to the Fairbees Anniversary Dance on May 11th. See our ad in this issue.

Memories of Square Dancing in Germany

Many years ago (1989), while stationed in Germany with the U.S. Army, my wife and I became interested in square dancing. We located a local club in Ansbach, Germany called "Tic-Tac-Toers". Even though the club was composed mainly of Germans from the local community, everyone spoke English. The club caller was very patient with us during our lessons and even gave me special attention by drawing an "L" and an "R" on the back of my hands. We soon learned Basic, Mainstream and Plus and happily joined the club. What we found was that the "Tic-Tac-Toers" were a part of the German-American Square Dance Federation with clubs all over Germany. We went on to visit several clubs in Southern Germany and discovered that, although there were only a few American dancers, everyone spoke English and all calls were in English.

What I remember most, besides the wonderful dancers we met, were the unique dancing experiences we encountered. I would like to share some of these experiences with you.

Germans are great lovers of the outdoors, and enjoy outdoor festivals and hiking in the local countryside. One activity they particularly enjoy is called "Volksmarching" (from German "*Volksmarsch*", *people's march*). Volksmarching is a form of non-competitive fitness walking that developed in Europe in the mid-late 1960s. Participants typically walk 5 kilometers (3.1 mi), 10 kilometers (6.2 mi), 20 kilometers (12 mi) or longer on a pre-determined outdoor path or trail. One day at a club meeting we decided to participate in these Volksmarches and introduce square dancing to participants. We had the Caller go ahead of the dancers with a portable sound system and set up shop at a 'rest stop' along the route and wait on us to arrive. The dancers, as a group, would walk the Volksmarch route and as we approached a rest stop or finish line we would pair up and promenade in. The Caller, upon seeing us, would turn on his system and start calling a 'tip'. Needless to say, it was interesting for we were not only hiking the outdoor trails, but were also dancing on dirt, gravel, concrete and cobblestone (interesting dance platform – cobblestone). We had a fantastic time and the locals also seemed to have enjoyed our exhibitions. As result of these Volksmarch exhibitions, our club was asked to perform other exhibitions at local village festivals all over Southern Germany. I guess you could say we became like the Medieval traveling minstrels. We would go to a village festival, dance, receive food and drink, and move on to the next village. It was great!

Our club was also the first, square dance club to have danced behind the "Iron Curtain" in the former East Germany. A couple of weeks before the fall of the Iron Curtain on 9 November 1989, our club was asked to preform an exhibition in the town of Plauen, just inside East Germany. The club chartered a bus and went from Ansbach in West Germany to a gym in Plauen, East Germany, where we performed the exhibition. Along the way our bus driver got lost and started to turn into an East German military base, where he was going to ask for directions. I remember jumping out of my seat in a panic (at the time, because of the security clearance I had with the military I was not allowed inside East Germany and would have been in big trouble had anyone learned I was there). I told the driver not to enter the base and he drove on past, to my everlasting relief. We eventually got to the gym and danced to a full house. Between 'tips' and afterwards, it was nice to interact with the local citizens, many of whom surprisingly spoke broken English. Several of the spectators asked us if it was possible for them to learn American square dancing. Our Caller told us that he and a few other callers were going to see if they could start new clubs in former East Germany as soon as the wall came down and travel would be easier. We have always been proud of fact that we may had been a small part of introducing square dancing into eastern Germany.

Another unique experience happened about a month later in early December 1989. Our club (Tic-Tac-Toers) always held our dances at the American Elementary School located in the U.S. Army family housing area in Ansbach, Germany. The school was a block or two away from the Commanding General's quarters so security was sort of tight. One night we were setting up for our regular club dance when three or four Eastern European cars, followed closely by both German and Army Military Police, drove up. The people in the cars were from Prague, Czechoslovakia (now Czech Republic) and spoke no German, English, French, Spanish, Dutch or Italian (all the languages our club members knew). The police were ready to take them all to jail for questioning when we decided to see if they could dance – they were after all wearing square dance attire. We paired off individually with them (each club member taking one of the visitors) and put them on the floor. It turned out they were, in fact, dancers. We found that toward the end of WW-II, a few American GI's had introduced American square dance to several people in Prague. Under the communist regime at the time, doing anything simulating western culture (and in particular American) was discouraged, if not outright illegal. The dancers had to go underground but continued dancing and even recruited new dancers. When the "Iron Curtain" came down, this was their first time they were able to dance out in public without fear of reprisals. Needless to say, it was a fantastic dance night, and one we will never forget!

We will always cherish the fond memories of our time in Germany. We had a fantastic time and are forever grateful to our extended square dance family – the Tic-Tac-Toers.
