FUN FACTS ABOUT MAY

- The name *May* is the modern-day English adaption of the Latin word *Maius*, which has origins going back to the time of the ancient Greeks. They named the month of May (or Maius) after the Greek goddess of growth.
- May was once considered an incredibly illomened time to get married. There's an adage for it actually, which goes: "*Marry in May and you'll rue the day*." It's not clear where exactly the saying comes from, but there must have been a pretty good reason not to get married in one of the most beautiful months of the year!
- The Empire State Building opened its doors on <u>May 1, 1931</u>. At the point of its construction, it held the record for being the tallest building in the world. Many other sky-high constructions have since dwarfed it, but it's still an aweinspiring feature of the New York cityscape!
- May is pretty exclusive when it comes to days of the week. No other month in one single year starts or finishes on the same weekday as May. Basically, if the first of May is on a <u>Friday</u>, and the 31st of May is on a Sunday, no other months in the year will start or end on a Friday or a <u>Sunday</u>!
- Many famous people were born in May, such as Mark Zuckerberg, Karl Marx, Clint Eastwood, Wes Anderson, John F. Kennedy, Queen Victoria, and Catherine the Great!
- May also has some pretty wacky days! <u>Hawaii</u> celebrates Lei Day on the first of May, which also happens to be <u>May Day</u>. Utah celebrates Golden Spike Day on <u>May 10th</u> after the First Transcontinental Railroad was completed. <u>May 29th</u> is celebrated as <u>Put a Pillow on Your Fridge Day</u>!
- As you can see, May isn't just a fantastic time of the year for weather – it's also got some pretty cool history.
- As the fifth month of the year, it would be so easy for it to slip by without notice, if not for all the interesting observances throughout the month!

.....AND he continues to teach line dancing at the Brazos Bottom Belles and Beaus Square Dance Club in Sugar Land on Tuesday nights.




