


### 2013 RECOGNITION AWARDS

### THE FUTURE OF THE WHERE'N'WHEN

We are all talking about what to do about the Where'n'When. Many people have strong feelings one way or the other: to print or not to print, that is the question. We all look at it from a different perspective. We would like to share with you our reasons for presenting these proposals from the view of the President-Elect.

**Budget**: We have to present to you the HSRDC budget for 2014. Right now, we cannot give you a balanced budget. Since we are losing nearly \$400 every month, we will be out of money in less than 10 years. Most of our other projects are holding their own, but the Where'n'When is losing most of that \$400/month. The electronic newsletter could bring that much in revenue to HSRDC, while still saving our member clubs up to \$60/month each.

**Other Newsletters**: We are not the first to consider the electronic only approach to our newsletter. The National Square Dance Convention has recently gone to an email only newsletter due to a low number of subscriptions. Most of the Texas Square Dance Associations have gone to either a quarterly newsletter or an electronic newsletter because of cost.

**Printing:** Many of you worry about having a printed copy. There are several ways to handle this:

- 1. Open the electronic Where'n'When and print it. You should be able to choose to print it in Color or Black & White (to save ink).
- 2. Have a friend show you how to print it or ask them to print it for you. If you have trouble printing, have a friend or relative help you. If they help you once, you can hopefully do it yourself the next time.
- 3. Buy a subscription. There will be a subscription price available. Someone will print a copy for you in Black & White and mail it to you.

The Future: Why the electronic only approach? We could go to a quarterly printed newsletter and keep our head above water. We could, but we would rather not. We need to move into the future, and the electronic newsletter IS THE FUTURE.

We would like to bring HSRDC into the future during the coming year. We would like to have your help in doing that. Come cast your vote on December 8th.

### SUMMARY OF PROPOSALS

This is a summary of 2 proposals brought to the Council at the last meeting. These proposals will be voted on at the meeting on Sunday, December 8, 2014. Remember: each club will have 4 votes.

Issue: Where'n'When is not paying for itself. We are currently losing an average of \$365/ monthly issue. HSRDC cannot balance their budget next year if we continue to operate as we are currently.

#### **HSRDC Exec Board Recommendations**

1) Suspend By-Laws requiring Monthly Newsletter for period 1-1-2014 thru 12-31-2014. This will allow Newsletter to be published quarterly Jan. 2014, Apr. 2014 and Jul. 2014 as a transition to new format. Updates can be sent via email coordinator if needed.

Current monthly income is \$700 and expenses are \$1,065 for printer and editor. **This is a loss of \$365/month**. Quarterly income would be \$1,600 and expenses of \$1,050 for printer. Editor would no longer be a paid position. This is a net gain of \$550/quarter.

- 2) Resume monthly publications in Oct. 2014 in an online format ONLY.
  - a. A printed copy can be mailed monthly for a subscription price of \$25.00/year.
  - b. Page Size will be 8 ½ x 11 inches
  - c. Ad space will increase due to larger page size. Everyone will get nearly twice as much space at a cheaper price.
  - i. 1/4 page is currently 3 x 3 inches (9 sq. in.) whereas the new size will be 3.75 x 5 inches (18 sq. in.) .
    - ii. 1/2 page will go from  $3.75 \times 6$  (22.5 sq. in.) inches to  $3.75 \times 10$  inches (37.5 sq. in.).
    - iii. Full page will go from  $6 \times 7.5$  inches (45 sq. in.) to  $7.5 \times 11$  inches (82.5 sq. in.).
    - d. Proposed Ad sizes and prices for member clubs will be
      - i. ¼ page \$20.00 (save \$4)
         ii. ½ page \$35.00 (save \$25)
         iii. Full page \$60.00 (save \$60)
    - e. Approximate income to HSRDC would be \$500/month.

Our lives were all about square dancing. An continued to be - through trials and tribulations, sickness and death. So you can just imagine, after all these years, what the Where n' When means to me.




